The contacts made by CCR&amp;R staff provided families with community resources, information about selecting high quality child care and other relevant information to the needs of the family. A variety of community events were attended throughout the year as well such as Fiesta Brevard, community outreach events and other family-centered activities.</p>

<p><b>Quality Activities for Infant &amp; Toddler Care:</b> Provide a description of the quality activities and services the coalition provided to enhance infant and toddler care.</p>	<p>A variety of the trainings offered during FY 13.14 provided professional development opportunities to infant and toddler teachers. The ELC of Brevard recognizes that this is a specific need for enhanced quality and provided specific training to address the need.</p>
<p><b>Monitoring:</b> Describe the process for monitoring of compliance with, and enforcement of, applicable state and local requirements.</p>	<p>The Coalition actively monitored providers for attendance and payment accuracy, School Readiness contract compliance items and VPK compliance. The Coalition’s Provider Relations Coordinators review each application for a contract and ensure initial compliance with contractual requirements. They also monitor those items throughout the year and communicate with providers to maintain compliance during the fiscal year. The Coalition’s reimbursement department conducts quality assurance measures on School Readiness and VPK providers in order to determine that appropriate payments were made based on documented attendance records. The Provider Relations Coordinators also work with license exempt providers to ensure that Health and Safety Checklists are completed and submitted to the Coalition.</p>

<p><b>Inclusion:</b> Describe the activities the coalition has implemented to promote inclusive child care including responding to Warm-Line requests by providers and parents and providing developmental and health screenings to school readiness program children.</p>	<p>The Coalition’s Inclusion Coordinator was actively involved in providing onsite technical assistance, conducting training and supporting providers with a variety of needs related to inclusion. The Inclusion Coordinator was also critically important to the implementation of the VPK SIS program. In addition, the Coalition’s Screening and Assessment Specialists conducted Ages and Stages Questionnaires (ASQ-3) on children as they attended their initial eligibility appointment. The Screening and Assessment Specialists worked closely with contracted child care providers to ensure that developmental screenings were conducted as required. They also worked closely with providers to support the administration of Teaching Strategies GOLD child assessments. Training was provided to those that volunteered to administer the tool in their classrooms and onsite technical assistance was provided to provide further support.</p>
