Training, professional development supports and technical assistance is provided at no cost to contracted providers and their early childhood educators.</p>

<p>Quality Activities for Infant & Toddler Care: Provide a description of the quality activities and services the coalition provided to enhance infant and toddler care.</p>	<p>In February 2016, the Coalition hosted its 7th Annual Child Care Provider Conference entitled “<i> Holding Hands, Touching Hearts and Shaping Little Minds.</i>” Several hundred practitioners, directors and owners attended this annual event. Many of the workshop sessions provided were related to enhancing the quality of infant and toddler care. The Coalition also hosted two mandatory Provider Meetings which included a variety of topics related to quality. The meetings were held in October 2015 and March 2016. In addition, the Board of Directors Quality Committee continued to participate in meaningful discussions related to opportunities for local quality initiatives, including providing support for providers to obtain accreditation which will begin in FY 16.17.</p>
<p>Monitoring: Describe the process for monitoring of compliance with, and enforcement of, applicable state and local requirements.</p>	<p>Utilizing the School Readiness monitoring tool requires cross-department efforts. The Coalition’s Quality Assurance and Finance Department staff share responsibilities for provider monitoring including onsite monitoring and desk reviews. Onsite monitoring is conducted for School Readiness and VPK providers and includes programmatic, contract as well as attendance monitoring. Corrective action processes are also in place to address those areas of needed follow up. Coalition staff continued to support providers with successful monitoring experiences by developing and facilitating a training entitled “School Readiness Monitoring: Heads Up! Triumph or Tragedy?” This training was offered at 7 times during July – September 2015 and was well attended.</p>

<p>Inclusion: Describe the activities the coalition has implemented to promote inclusive child care including responding to Warm-Line requests by providers and parents and providing developmental and health screenings to school readiness program children.</p>	<p>The Coalition saw an increase in requests for information and enrollments related to the VPK SIS program in FY 2015 – 2016. The ELC’s Inclusion Specialist dedicated a significant amount of time and resources during the year working with VPK SIS families and providers. In addition, the Inclusion Coordinator has been instrumental in coordinating and facilitating local and regional conversations with other inclusion professionals. The Inclusion Specialist participates in quarterly Inclusion Roundtable trainings and meetings and is regularly in attendance at Early Steps staff meetings. The Coalition is currently working with Brooke’s to transition the service delivery for developmental screenings to the utilization of Family Access for ASQ. The Coalition continues to provide vision and hearing screenings for all enrolled School Readiness children.</p>

Training and Technical Assistance

Offered to Providers

Early Learning Standards – None offered (online option available)

Child Screenings and Assessments

Supporting the VPK GOLD Assessment with Documentation, Observation and Anecdotal Note Taking – Assists teachers in learning how to effectively observe and document children's progress using VPK GOLD Objectives as your guide. Participants will learn strategies to gather documentation and anecdotal notes as well as learning how the VPK Gold Objectives for Development and Learning align to the current Standards for Four Year Olds. (July 2015)

Kids Say the Darndest Things: Anecdotal Note Taking in Early Childhood Classrooms - Focuses on how and why teachers should use anecdotal notes when assessing child development in the early childhood classroom. We will explore ways teachers can influence learning and create developmentally appropriate activities based on factual information obtained while using anecdotal records. We will discuss teacher strategies and review how anecdotal note taking can assist with curriculum or assessments such as Teaching Strategies GOLD. (July 2015)

Observation and Documentation for VPK GOLD –Designed for VPK lead and assistant teachers that will be utilizing the Teaching Strategies GOLD approach to early childhood assessments. Taking accurate observational notes is essential for the successful implementation of the Teaching Strategies GOLD Tool. This Section will explore several techniques to create functional observational notes in order for teachers to provide documentation to assist in GOLD child assessments and help plan developmental appropriate learning activities. (Several sessions in August and September 2015)

VPK Assessment – The Florida Voluntary Pre-Kindergarten (VPK) Assessment provides valuable information regarding the monitoring and assessing children's academic progress and how this information can be used to meet the instructional needs of each child. Includes how to administer, record and score each assessment measure. (September and December 2015)

VPK Assessment Instructional Implications – Provides information regarding the utilization of VPK Assessment results to inform classroom instruction. (December 2015)

Developmentally Appropriate Curricula and Character Development

Open-Ended Art for Toddlers – Will help teachers of Toddlers incorporate open-ended art experiences into the classroom routine. Open-ended art experiences encourage the child to build upon the experience rather than the final product. Join us to help your toddler explore art and develop his imagination. (August 2015)

Kinesthetic Teaching – Incorporating Creative Movement in the Classroom – Movement is a means of communication. Through it children express emotions, learn new concepts, develop motor skills, improve balance and develop creativity and imagination. Since children think with their bodies and they love to move, teachers need to include body-centered learning within their instruction. In this training, teachers will learn how to engage the whole body into their academic learning classroom. (September 2015)

Road Blocks Ahead, Instructional Scaffolding – Scaffolding is an instructional technique, where teachers afford personalized support by incrementally improving a student’s capacity to build on previous knowledge. Together we will explore the concept of scaffolding, consider various kinds of scaffolding and identify how to apply scaffolding to a particular learning situation/student. (September 2015)

Multiple Modalities – Preferred Learning Styles – What are modalities? What are learning styles? How are the sensory channels engaged in learning? This training will help identify the concepts of learning styles/preferences and to design an adaptable learning environment addressing multiple modalities. (October 2015)

The Unmeasurables – Promoting Character Development - Good character doesn’t happen by chance, it has to be purposefully taught! Educators play a critical role in supporting character education based on shared ethical values. Here is an opportunity for participants to discuss character development (CD), identify the contributing factors of CD and examine the implementation CD in the classroom. (October 2015)

Organizational Skills as a Foundation for Infant and Toddler Care - Infant/toddler growth and development are all impacted by safe environment, overall health conditions, social emotional care, nutrition, challenging behaviors, parent and other essential relationships. When we establish an organized approach to each of these areas, we increase our opportunities for greater long-term success and productivity. (June 2016)

Teacher-Child Interactions – None offered

Age-Appropriate Discipline Practices

Guiding Behavior: Temperaments and Learning Styles of Young Children - This professional development event focuses on guiding children’s behaviors in an appropriate manner in order to foster positive outcomes. Participants will explore appropriate discipline for young children and discuss ways to respond appropriately to different learning styles and temperaments. (July 2016)

Health and Safety – None offered

Nutrition

CATCH Information and Collaboration Session - Come learn about CATCH Early Childhood, an evidence-based physical activity, nutrition and gardening program for preschoolers, ages 3-5. This will be a hands-on and discussion workshop for directors and teachers who are interested in learning more about the program, as well as currently trained teachers, who can share best practices and collaborate. (September 2015)

Child Abuse Detection and Prevention

Trauma Informed Care - Learning objectives will include defining what traumatic stress is and how it impacts children. Through discussion and videos we will explore what a child who experiences traumatic events might look like and how they might behave. We will consider how children experience trauma and how your interactions and care of them can help mitigate the impact of the trauma they experience. Lastly, we will discuss and define what it is to be truly trauma informed and how to help support children and families. (October 2015)
