COMPREHENSIVE CONSUMER EDUCATION

Describe how the Coalition coordinated resource and referral programs specifically related to the provision of comprehensive consumer education to parents and the public regarding participation in the school readiness program and parental choice.

During fiscal year 2019-2020, the Early Learning Coalition of Brevard continued its efforts to provide high quality Child Care Resource and Referral services to the community. Despite a global pandemic and the threat of several hurricanes, the Coalition was able to participate in various virtual CCR&R trainings by OEL's CCRR Network. Information received from these trainings was disseminated to seasoned CCR&R and blended staff as well as newly hired staff. CCR&R training and/or technical assistance is continuously provided to the CCR&R and Blended staff by the CCR&R Coordinator as needed. To better serve our community, the CCR&R department was reorganized and services were streamlined by creating a Family Engagement & Community Outreach department. This department now has four (4) CCR&R certified staff, dedicated to CCR&R services only, in addition to the blended staff. Services continue to be provided following the CCR&R rules and requirements, as well as the CCR&R Best Practices and Front Door to Services model.

- During FY 19-20, the Coalition continued to support participation and payment differentials/quality incentives are based on providers Classroom Assessment Scoring System (CLASS®) composite score.
- Providers offering Child Assessments also receive a payment differential/incentive if they submit accordingly in the required benchmarks.
- The Coalition successfully sent four Brevard providers to participate and graduate the BLI Business Institute for Early Learning Entrepreneurs with Orange County.
- The Coalition had to cancel its' 11th annual child care provider conference, *Renew the Passion*, in lieu of COVID 19 Pandemic.
- The Coalition was able to provide thru federal relief legislation provide support to providers during the COVID 19 Pandemic. These supports were passed in three phases. Parent Fees waived; Provider Mini-Grants for Professional Development, Infrastructure and Health and Safety Cleaning Supplies; CCDF-CARES Act Funded

Initiatives- First Responders/Health Care Workers Direct Services and Bonus Grant for Providers; Phase I and Phase II: Supports to Contracted and Non-Contracted Child Care Centers.

- The Coalition – Provider Services Department – Quality Assurance Specialists (QAS) conduct monitoring of all service contracts to verify if providers are meeting agreed upon benchmarks and deliverables as established by contract and funding requirements. The QAS team prepare and update an annual monitoring schedule to reflect OEL requirements. The monitoring process consists of desk top and on site reviews. This information is used to monitor contract compliance and verification of services rendered. This department monitors over fifty percent of VPK providers and a percentage of Low Performing Providers (LPP), School Readiness provider curriculums and attendance sheets. The team works with DCF Licensing Staff to ensure compliancy with licensing requirements.

QUALITY ACTIVITIES FOR INFANT AND TODDLER CARE

Provide a description of the quality activities and services the coalition provided to enhance infant and toddler care.

The ELC of Brevard had a staff member in FY 19-20 that was significantly engaged in OEL's Infant Toddler Network during the fiscal year. She participated on regularly scheduled calls and attended face-to-face meetings when offered. She ended her employment with ELC. We have a new staff member who is incredibly passionate and committed. Discussions continue to be had for the need for more targeted Infant Toddler professional development activities in the future. Coalition staff continue to see gaps in available infant care in some areas of the community. Discussions have occurred and will continue about strategies to increase the availability of high quality infant programs in the community.

The importance of early literacy continues to be key theme in the coalition's outreach programs to children and families. The Coalition provided books to providers to continue to encourage reading.

MONITORING

The Coalition continued to support providers through the required monitoring events

during the fiscal year. School Readiness and VPK providers were monitored utilizing the required tools and in compliance with the established requirements. Again this year, the Coalition supported providers by offering trainings that were designed to provide a positive monitoring experience for all involved. School Readiness Monitoring and VPK Contract Compliance Training was provided to all new providers. The intent of these trainings is to prepare new providers and to serve as a refresher for existing providers on School Readiness and VPK monitoring. These trainings assist providers with the content of the monitoring tool with a focus on encouraging successful monitoring experiences.

The Coalition also continued a positive working relationship with the local DCF licensing staff. Communication occurs regularly regarding potential licensing violations, program questions and other areas where sharing information leads to greater compliance and quality. In addition, ELC staff participate in Institutional Staffing and trainings offered.

INCLUSION

Describe the activities the coalition has implemented to promote inclusive child care including responding to Warm-Line requests by providers and parents and providing developmental and health screenings to school readiness program children.

The Early Learning Coalition of Brevard continued to implement a collaborative team approach to provide inclusion services to our providers and families and to benefit from additional supports via the Warm Line requests. Inclusion and developmental screening services were offered to ELCB families and the community. Meetings were scheduled with the teacher/director and parents to address concerns observed in the classroom. The Inclusion Specialist also conducted trainings at multiple provider location regarding multiple inclusion topics.

All children enrolled in School Readiness services were provided developmental screens utilizing the ASQ-3. During the initial months of COVID-19, from March 2020 thru June 2020, the Coalition continued to utilize ASQ Enterprise, the online parent option to complete the required ASQ's. This approach is a research proven way to obtain developmental screening information on the children participating in the School Readiness program. Coalition staff also provided face to face screening or discussion when needed. Families of children with scores indicating concerns, were provided support activities and re-screening opportunities. Coalition staff also assisted in referrals for IEP or IFSP services to identified children.

ELCB Inclusion staff continues to actively collaborate with community partners such as Help Me Grow, 211 Brevard, Early Steps, Early Head Start, Head Start, Brevard Public Schools/FDLRS-Child Find, United Way of Brevard, Brevard County Department of Health and other community partners. Coalition staff are members of the local Help Me Grow Steering Committee and collaborate in joint community outreach events.
